

Agreement of Responsibility

To participate in the 2010 FLAGG Community Garden Project I understand and agree to the following policies and responsibilities:

The garden plots will be assigned by May 15th and planting can begin starting May 24th.

I / We will maintain my garden plot through the end of the growing season and will have my plot cleared of debris by November 1st.

I will plant tall crops where they will not shade neighboring plots.

I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another plot user.

I will NOT use fertilizers, insecticides or weed repellents that will in any way affect other plots.

I will NOT bring pets to the garden area.

There will be NO fencing or man made structures other than plant supports and a sign identifying the garden plot/gardener allowed. ID Sign can be no larger than 12"x24" on a 36" stake. Naming your garden and creative signage is encouraged.

If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the garden leadership.

I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot if any.

I will keep trash and litter out of the plot and will participate in the fall cleanup of the garden.

I / We will attend as many educational learning sessions as possible to understand the importance of how three ingredients (Education – Nutrition – Financial Cost Savings) will benefit me in having a FLAGG Garden.

I / We understand that the FLAGG sponsors are providing the community gardens as a benefit to the citizens of Ashland County on a not for profit volunteer organization basis. I will not hold the land owner or any FLAGG partner responsible for my actions. I THEREFORE AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS THE GARDEN GROUP AND OWNERS OF THE LAND FOR ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGE, LOSS OR CLAIM THAT OCCURS IN CONNECTION WITH USE OF THE FLAGG GARDEN BY ME OR ANY OF MY GUESTS.
